Dear Students:

Two Student Societies had held an absurd anti-China speech on February 11th in McMaster University, under the disguise of helping Uighur woman and orphans, boldly roused East Turkestan separatist activity, promoted hatred between races, attacked China government. By taking advantage of these, to appeal funds. We already fully aware of this situation and had hold collective meeting between Chinese Student Societies within few hours. We are strongly indignant towards this kind of activities which confuse people with right and wrong and want to severely condemn it.

We already contacted the University and informed them this in the first time and expressed our dissatisfaction. We requested the University to strictly conduct supervision on the activities held in University. Currently, we are awaiting response from the University side.

We have informed the Consulate-general of the People's Republic of China in Toronto about this in the early morning of 12th.
