UPDATE

The service has been doing quite well over the past few months. We have been able to continuously post on our assigned days, with one day allocated to the arts quad and the second allocated to the science quad. SERVICE USAGE

The service will begin focusing on where it fits in best with the MSU as well as what the service can provide for additional support to the various services. As such, meetings with the clubs administrator and various MSU PTMs have been set up in order to discuss what they feel they are lacking and what additional services they believe will be a benefit to them. Furthermore, working with the underground, we are in the process of generating new and updated maps for our website in order to efficiently indicate to our users of which boards PAC has control of.

CURRENT CHALLENGES

As mentioned before, PAC has continued to be quite successful over the past few months. One small challenge that was brought to my attention was the removal of specific posters. Although the dates on the stamp were expired, the individuals still remained frustrated that we had removed their posters. As such, after meeting with Michael Wooder and Anna D'Angela, we discussed a few additional guidelines that PAC has begun to consider when posting. These guidelines consist of:

A poster shall remain posted, even with an expired MSU stamp given the specific conditions that:

- A) There is no date specified on the poster for which it expires. (ie. A poster searching for volunteers for a research project ending in 2014.)
- B) There is still room on the board after putting up the newly received posters.
- C) The event date has yet to pass

I have set up a few meetings in hopes to discuss the future plans associated with PAC. While nothing to large is happening just yet, we are looking forward to hearing back from the clubs administrator and various services on what they feel they will benefit from the most.
