UPDATE

The service has been continuously smooth over the past few months. With the new term upon us, we have been able to keep our assigned days, with Monday allocated towards the arts quad and Wednesdays allocated towards the science quad. SERVICE USAGE

PAST EVENTS, PROJECTS & ACTIVITIES

UPCOMING EVENTS, PROJECTS & ACTIVITIES

Postering will continue on the scheduled days, even as midterms proceed within these upcoming weeks. Along with this, after meeting with Anna D'Angela, we were able to develop a revised plan of the direction that PAC will begin to take. The service as a whole will move away from a solo MSU service and will be integrated into the services that the Underground provides. As such, this will eliminate any secondary steps that the user will have to take and instead, provides users with the opportunity to start and finish setting up their postering needs from the same location. Furthermore, as this transition begins to occur, we will continue cleaning out our assigned closet so that it may be reassigned within the next academic year.

OTHER

Although it is unfortunate that PAC will no longer stand as a solo service, this transition will be beneficial to both the users as well as the Underground. Integrating PAC in with the Underground will help maximize both the services that PAC provides along with
