The Bylaws and Procedures Committee is underway in a number of projects, and is looking forward to making progress in the upcoming weeks. Below is an update on the projects that we're currently working on. A reminder that our committee is always receptive to new ideas and would love your input on any of our projects. First Year Council

Looking into updating the First Year Council Bylaw and supporting the FYC was identified as a project that our committee was interested in pursuing. We will be discussing and potentially voting upon FYC Bylaw revisions at our upcoming meeting, focusing on clarifying certain roles within FYC and improving accountability. Additionally, I have reached out to the incoming FYC members, and will hopefully keep in contact with them throughout the year to receive ongoing feedback and identify long term revisions to support the FYC.

General Assembly

At our meeting this week, we will be discussing the General assembly, its bylaw, and plan moving forward to make revisions to implement and support the planning of the GA this year. I will be in close contact with the GA planning committee throughout the rest of the term, and are looking forward to see what positive changes we can make for this upcoming GA.

Constitutional Implications

We had recently broken off into sub-committees to research individual projects, one of which was our project with regards to the constitutional implications. We have had discussions on potential options moving forward, but right now this project will be on the back-burner as we continue to do research.

Accountability Bylaw/Policy
